

## **Easter Egg Holder Instructions**

## *Items you will need for this project:*

Fibrous water soluble stabilizer

Fabric for the front of the holder- this piece should be 1" longer and 1"wider than the finished size of the design Fabric spray adhesive

Note: The outline and tackdown color changes are for the appliquéd area(s) of the design. The outline is a running stitch line that defines the appliqué's shape. Your piece of fabric should be a little bigger than the outline. The tackdown is a running stitch line that will stitch inside the outline to tack down the fabric. Trim the fabric close to the tackdown stitches

1. Hoop two pieces of fibrous water-soluble stabilizer.



2. Stitch the first color change; this is your outline for the fabric placement.



3. Remove the hoop from the machine. Using a very light spray of adhesive; place the fabric on the stabilizer, using the outline stitch as a guide.



- 4. Place the hoop back onto the machine and stitch the second color change; which is the tack down stitch.
- 5. Remove the hoop from the machine. Trim the fabric on the outside of the tack down stitches.





6. Place the hoop back onto the machine, and stitch the remaining color changes.





Your Easter egg holder is now complete!

- 7. Remove from the hoop.
- 8. Trim the stabilizer close to the fabric.



- 9. Use a small brush or Q-tip to apply water to dissolve the water soluble stabilizer.
- 10. Add Velcro for closure.
