970979 Instructions for Bracelets


Materials needed:

2 pieces of water soluble stabilizer
5x7 embroidery hoop
Embroidery Thread for each design
Large eyed needle
Scissor
Sharp tool to poke holes open
Paper towel for drying design
2 Thin Ribbon cut 10 inches each

- 1. Choose the Bracelet Pattern you want to embroider.
- 2. Hoop the 2 pieces of water soluble stabilizer.



- 3. Choose threads for project.
- 4. Embroider bracelet design.



- 5. Take out of hoop and cut close to edge of design being careful not to cut threads. Don't worry about leaving some water soluble stabilizer it will dissolve once it is wet.
- 6. Place bracelet under water until is it totally wet.
- 7. Lay flat on paper towel. Blot by moving the design a couple times to help dry and dissolve the soluble stabilizer.


- 8. Once it is dry poke the end circles, where the satin stitches are, with a sharp object be careful not to cut the satin stitches on the outside of the circle.
- 9. With the scissor cut the excess threads off the back so they do not show on the front of the bracelet.



10. Take one of the 10 inch ribbons and thread it through the hole. We used a needle to help the loop end through. After threading run the needle back through and pull on one of the loose ribbon ends while holding the loop to get the needle out.







11. Tie it to the wrist leaving a small gap so it is not too tight. Trim excess ribbon off.
