Instructions for Greeting Card Frames

Items you will need for this project:

Fibrous water soluble stabilizer

One 6" X 8" pieces of fabric

5" X 7" Blank Cards and envelopes (available at your local craft/hobby store)

Double sided tape

1. Lightly spray the back of the piece of fabric with an adhesive.
2. Hoop two pieces of fibrous water-soluble stabilizer.
3. Stitch the first color change, which is your outline for the frame.
4. Place the fabric over the outline stitches.
5. Stitch the second color change, which is the tack down stitch.
6. Trim the fabric on the outside and the inside of the frame close to the tack down stitches.
7. Embroider the design, following the remaining color changes.
8. Remove from the hoop.
9. Trim the stabilizer close to the stitches along the satin stitches.
10. Use a q-tip or paint brush to run water along the outside edges to remove the fibrous water soluble stabilizer.
11. Adhere the frame to the card with double sided tape.
12. Add text, photographs, bling, buttons, ribbon etc.
