Cutwork Instructions

Items you will need:

Fibrous water soluble stabilizer or tear away stabilizer Bobbin(s) to wind Spray adhesive if it is too small to hoop Scissors with a fine point (we like the blades with a curve)

We suggest that you wind your bobbin with the thread you will use when you embroider the cutwork designs if the back of embroidery will be visible (napkins, scarves, etc.).

- 1. Hoop the fabric with one piece of the stabilizer
- 2. After the cut line is stitched, trim the fabric to the inside of the cut line. Do not cut the stabilizer.
- 3. Embroider the rest of the design.

If the item is too small to hoop:

- 1. Hoop one piece of the stabilizer.
- 2. Do a light spray of the adhesive on the stabilizer.
- 3. Adhere the item to the stabilizer.
- 4. After the cut line is stitched, trim the fabric to the inside of the cut line. Do not cut the stabilizer.
- 5. Embroider the rest of the design.

Note: If the item will be washed often we suggest that you use a fray inhibitor (We use Fray Block.)
